# The Pirates' 10 points for a fair municipality of Mondercange

## 1. Security

First responders in Monnerech & Pontpierre for quick medical aid & bring the police station back to Monnerech (open 8am-6pm).



## 2. Traffic & Transportation

Instead of years of empty promises, ease traffic and find solutions to improve transit transportation (enlargement of traffic circles at Foetz and Pontpierre, definitive implementation of the safe school road, etc.).

## 3. Young & Old & Family Life

No Montessorri system in our Maison Relais, transport system for children for activities such as sports and music. Resumption of pre-corona activities at the A. Bosselsch center.

## 4. Club life

FC Monnerech's Field 3 should remain open as promised in 2018. Clubs should have access to adequate field or hall capacity. At events, healthy food should also be sold.

## 5. Housing

The municipality should purchase a lot more building land, build houses on it, and rent it out for 10 €/m2. Encourage environmentally friendly investments. Build no large residential areas (in Foetz or elsewhere). Our community's rural character should be preserved.

## 6. Finances

There should not be more going out than coming in. Reduce our community's corporate income tax. Abolish the dog tax.

## 7. Co-determination & Transparency

Community meetings should be open to the public. Citizen councils and referendums should be established. Local politicians' conflicts of interest should be avoided at all costs and made public. More information for citizens in general.

## 8. Living Together

Our community should join the Fair Trade label. Improved integration of foreigners and refugees (for example, through free Luxembourgish courses), collaboration with a foreign community.

## 9. Environment

The Pirates want an energy self-sufficient municipality by 2030. This includes storing rainwater, increasing electromobility, using intelligent lighting, investing in photovoltaics where feasible, and going "paperless" wherever possible.

## 10. Digitalisation

Municipal services should be made available as e-services wherever possible. The municipality app should be expanded, and our municipality should provide free WiFi.
